

Charities at Christmas 2019

Fundraising in December supported a number of charities and the following amounts have been sent to the charities listed:

Crisis £453. Collections at the carol service and on Christmas morning.
 Action for Children £504. Mostly raised at the carol service and on Christmas morning but supplemented by money raised at the Christmas Tree Festival.

Street Pastors £627. The final total from the Christmas Tree Festival.

Jeel Al Amal School in Bethany £330. The Christmas Friday Lunch raised this for the McCabe Educational Trust.

In addition to those Christmas-specific donations, other charities were helped:

Little People £140. From another Friday lunch in December. The money helped buy Christmas presents for children.

Be Free Young Carers £300. From two events: a "clothes swap" and a YMOSES fundraising social evening.

All We Can £540. From regular giving and an unexpected cheque. **Fund for Human Need** £250. From Monday morning "Community Café". The total of £3,144 is a tribute to the hard work, dedication and generosity of church members and friends.
