Use of the Church Car Park for Sunday Morning Services

The reality of our church's parking facilities is that they are inadequate for our needs. This has necessitated a rethink of how we can continue to assist those with serious mobility needs and do all we can to enable them to attend Sunday Morning Services safely.

After careful consideration of how best to resolve this problem, the system proposed and agreed by the Church Leadership Team, with immediate implementation, is as follows:

- On Sunday mornings, the entire car park, except the space reserved for the Minister or Worship Leader, will be restricted for use only by those whose disability necessitates arrival by car onto the church site.
- Permits have been given to each qualifying disabled regular worshipper, and to drivers who regularly give lifts to any of these people.
- Anyone who needs a permit in the future should make their request to one of the Church Stewards.
- Please remember that the slope leading to Church Street must be kept clear for pedestrian access, especially those who use a walking aid or need to hold onto the arm of a helper.
