#### Wantage Coffee Morning and Gift Day

We are holding a church **coffee morning and gift day** on **Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> April from 10 am – 12 noon.** We warmly invite you to come along and join us.

The Church will be open for quiet reflection with background music being played. Tea, coffee, and cake will be available in the hall and Keith and Heather (our Treasurer) will be in the church parlour ready to receive your gifts (whether by cheque, cash, or by bank transfer) or to let them know that you feel able to increase your regular offering. This will of course, be kept confidential. They will also be able to answer any questions you may have regarding the church finances etc.

We are very aware that these are economically difficult times, and that money is tight, but we have a responsibility to balance the church's books.

Discussing our financial situation will also be part of our conversation at the General Church Meeting the following day.

In a service Keith led in January this year on the theme of "Buried Treasure", Keith reminded us of the four markers that help us to reflect on our giving and how we use our money.
